## Driving Under the Influence

DUI stand for **Driving Under the Influence**. Drinking alcohol or taking drugs can **impair driving skills** in various ways, including: slowing reaction time, decreasing coordination, causing drowsiness, and impairing cognitive functioning (thinking and judgment). All of these effects can lead to **vehicle crashes**.

After alcohol, **marijuana** is the drug most often found in the blood of drivers involved in crashes. The vehicle crash risk associated with marijuana in combination with alcohol, cocaine, or prescription drugs is greater than that for each drug by itself.
